

2019 National Championship Forms Overview

Listed below are forms you will need for the 2019 National High School Mock Trial Championship. Examples of the forms are on the Materials page of the Athens2019 website for your use and review. Do note which forms teams are responsible for bringing to Athens and which will be provided.

Below is a brief explanation of the purpose and use for each form used at Nationals.

Forms that must be completed and brought to Athens

- 2019 Team Rosters: Note that there are two separate rosters: one for Beauregard and one for Sherman. Each form should be completed on the PDF and printed; barring an emergency change in Athens, handwritten forms should not be used. The forms include a place to indicate the team code, which your team will receive the week of May 6.
 - For each round of competition, you will provide copies of your completed roster to the presiding judge, the three scoring evaluators, and opposing counsel, for a total of 5 copies per round. It's important to bring the correct number of copies with you to the competitions as staff will not have the ability to make copies of any of your forms. We recommend bringing 15 to 20 copies of each roster for the preliminary rounds and 14 for the Final Round.
- 2019 Photo & Video Release Form: During the course of the competition, staff and news media
 will take photos and/or videos of students participating in the competition. This signed form
 signifies that the State Bar of Georgia and the National High School Mock Trial Championship,
 Inc. have been given permission to use photographs and/or videos taken at any of the 2019
 competition events for educational and/or promotional materials and publications. Each student
 (and a parent/guardian for students under 18) must fill out and return this form when the team
 registers on May 15 or 16 in Athens.

Forms that will be provided to teams in Athens

- 2019 Star Witness & Attorney Certificates: During each round of competition, the competing students on each team will decide who they think was the best witness and attorney from the opposing team and present them with a certificate at the conclusion of the critique. Copies of the forms will be included in the team's registration packet. Teams are responsible for ensuring they bring the certificates with them to each round of competition.
- The Larry Bakko Professionalism & Civility Award: The nomination ballot will be included in your team's registration packet and will need to be completed and returned to your Presiding Judge at the end of the 4th Round. Criteria for this award are described in full on the other side of the ballot.
